to surrender to the cabinet upon demand, any operator's license which has been suspended, canceled or revoked; use a false name or give a false address in any application for an operator's license or any renewal or duplicate, or knowingly make a false statement or knowingly conceal a material fact or otherwise commit a fraud in any application or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act.
